**Consumer's Use Tax Amnesty Ends May 1, 2013**

*Applications must be postmarked by May 1<sup>st</sup>*

The end is near.

Ohio's Consumer's Use Tax Amnesty program shuts down Wednesday, May 1, 2013. This program is meant to help businesses who may not be aware they owe use tax or have fallen behind in paying their use tax liabilities. Companies that are eligible to participate may qualify to pay past liability while avoiding penalty and interest. To take advantage of the program, you must act soon.

If you are behind on your consumer's use tax and have not received an assessment notice, you may qualify for amnesty. In order to be considered for amnesty, the application must be postmarked by the final day of the program: May 1<sup>st</sup>.
