Can Paperless Filing Work For You?

Are you a regular county vendor (account numbers beginning with 01 – 88) with sales tax to report and pay for only one county? Do you have zero sales tax to report and pay for the return filing period? If you answered yes to either of these questions, then Telefile is for you. Single county vendors can file and pay form UST-1 by calling 1-800-697-0440. All vendors, regardless of the number of counties to report, can use the Ohio Business Gateway (OBG) to file and pay returns. You can also use the OBG to file and pay employer withholding tax, school district income tax, and the commercial activity tax. Visit the OBG at obg.ohio.gov. Save time and expense, file paperless!!

New Form ST-CRDO

The Ohio General Assembly passed legislation, S. B. 218, enacting a new section of the Ohio Revised Code, 5739.24. This section requires cumulative return filers, also known as master account holders (account numbers 89-X3XXXX), to file a new report with the Ohio Department of Taxation every six months. This new report is a Cumulative Filing Report for Destination and Origin Sales (form ST-CRDO). The information on this form will allow the Ohio Department of Taxation to determine the amount of compensation that will be provided to impacted counties for loss of revenue that may result due to the change to destination-based sourcing tax collection. The first report will cover the period of January 1, 2006 through June 30, 2006 and is due by July 30, 2006. Failure to file penalties may be applied. Affected vendors should receive information in June 2006 regarding this new filing requirement.

Vendor Compensation

Vendors that have incurred costs associated with switching to destination-based sourcing may be eligible for compensation.
