



## **2013 Ohio Individual Income and School District Income Taxes - Full payment has not been received**

The Ohio Department of Taxation records show that you have not remitted **full** payment for your 2013 Ohio individual income tax (Ohio form IT-1040) and your 2013 Ohio Individual School District income tax (Ohio form SD-100). The payments were due on 4/15/2014. Any tax paid after that date may be subject to interest and penalties. If you paid the balance due in full, please disregard this email. Notice to taxpayers in Bankruptcy: This is a notice of tax deficiency permissible pursuant to 11 USC Section 362 (b)(9).

**Note:** If this email address was used on more than one Ohio tax return, make sure all returns utilizing this email address showing a balance due were paid in full. (e.g., Tax preparers who used one common email address for all the client's tax returns, or family members who prepare taxes for other family members and share one common email address.)

If the amount due was not paid in full, you may use one of the payment options below to remit the balance due:

### **1. Pay Online (electronic check or credit card\*)**

- Go to our home page at [tax.ohio.gov](http://tax.ohio.gov) and click "Pay On-Line"
- Click "Ohio ePayment"
  - Enter User ID and Password. If you have not previously registered for this service, click "Register".
- Once you are logged into Online Services, you will see a dashboard displaying tax returns on file where you may view your 2013 Ohio tax return information. You may also view previous payments made under the View/Make Payment option on the left menu.

### **2. Pay by Telephone (credit card only\*)**

- Call 1-800-272-9829
- Select State Taxes (option 2)
- Enter jurisdiction code 6446
- Select one of the following:
  - State of Ohio Individual Income Tax Billing Notice Payment (option 3)
  - State of Ohio School District Income Tax Billing Notice Payment (option 4)
- Enter Social Security Number and first three letters of last name
- Enter one of the following:
  - Notice ID 4001 for Income Tax
  - Notice ID 7001 for School District Income Tax
- Enter Tax Year 2013

*\*Note: Payments made by electronic check are free. Official Payments Corporation provides the credit card service for payments made with a credit card. There is a convenience fee of 2.5% or \$1.00 (whichever is greater) for their service. The State of Ohio does not receive any portion of this fee.*

### **3. Pay by Paper Check**

- Write a check for each balance due and include a completed [2013 Ohio IT-40P payment coupon](#) and [2013 Ohio School District SD-40P coupon](#).
- Mail your check and payment coupon to the address listed on the coupon.

Failure to pay your Ohio income and School District income taxes will result in further collection action that may subject you to interest and penalties as prescribed by Ohio law:

- The interest rate on any unpaid tax due in 2014 is 3%.
- Late payment penalty is double the interest.
- The Department of Taxation is not authorized to set up a payment plan.
