

IT 10 – Ohio Income Tax Information Notice

**For use only by individuals claiming to owe no Ohio individual income tax for the year.
This notice must be filed by the filing deadline.**

Although you may not be required to file an Ohio income tax return, filing this notice may help you avoid being considered a delinquent taxpayer. If your filing status is married filing jointly and you want to file this notice, you can do so only if your spouse is eligible to file this notice.
