(B) One hundred per cent (100%) of the remaining revenue after cost of the aforesaid will go into the general revenue fund of the Village of Valley Hi, Ohio.

SECTION XIII: EXCLUSIONS FROM TAX

(A) Welfare checks, social security checks, unemployment benefits, workmen's compensation checks, or any benefits received as the result of disability from local, state or federal government, or charitable, religious or educational organizations.

(B) Insurance dividends, or payment on a death claim.

(C) Dues, contributions, grants received by charitable, religious or educational organizations, labor unions, trade or professional associations, from entertainment, amusements, sport events, or other such activities when conducted by a bona fide charitable, religious or educational organization.

SECTION XIV: CREDIT FOR TAX PAID IN ANOTHER MUNICIPALITY

Every taxpayer who is resident of Valley Hi, but who receives salary, wages, commission, directors fees or other compensation for work done or services performed outside the Village of Valley Hi, Ohio, will be credited for payment of tax if he can establish that he pays tax in another municipality. He should be able to produce a receipt or other material which will verify payment in another municipality.

SECTION XV: DECLARING AN EMERGENCY IN THE VILLAGE OF VALLEY HI, OHIO

This ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure needed to raise revenue to pay operating costs of the Village of Valley Hi, Ohio, to preserve the safety, public peace and health of its residents.
